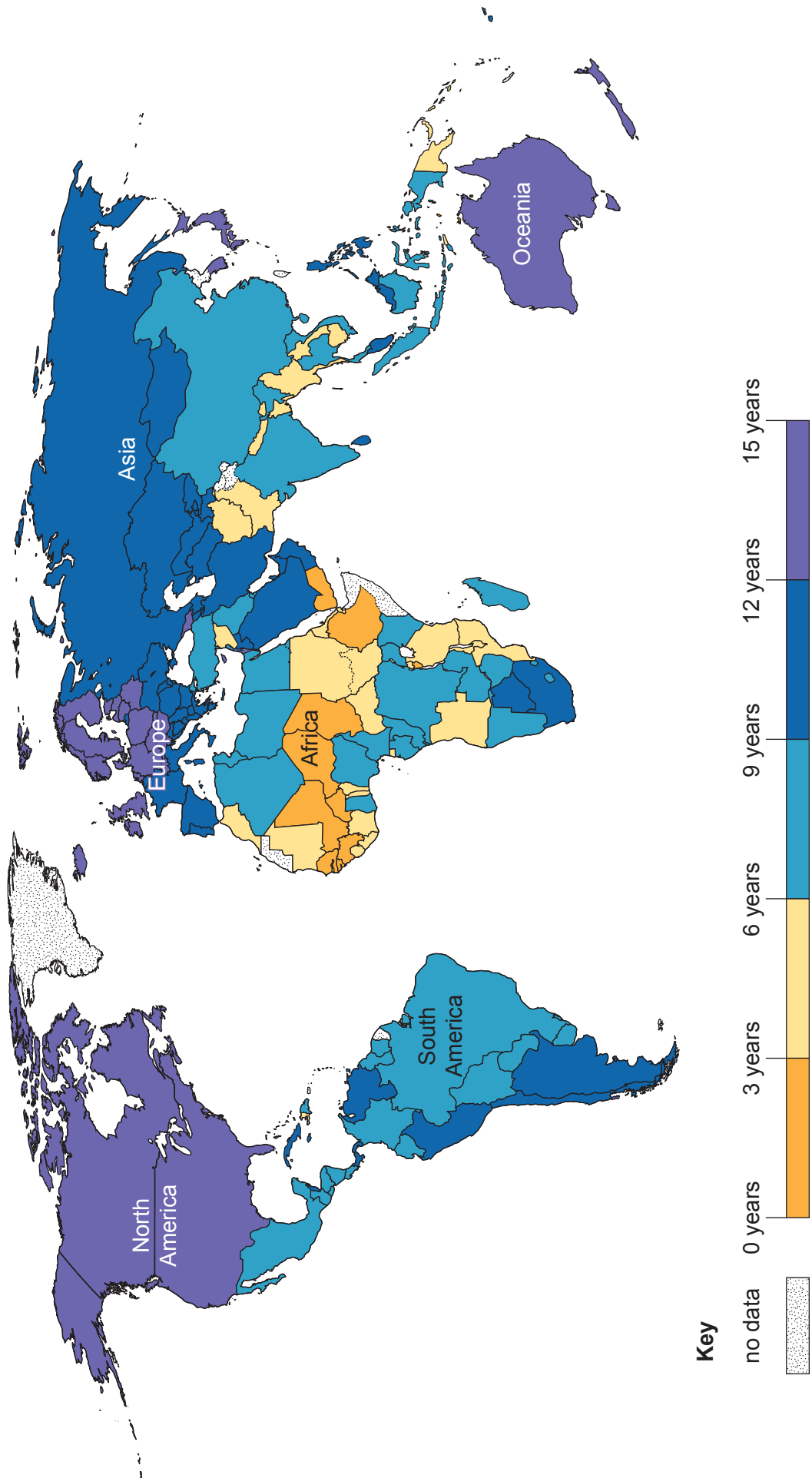

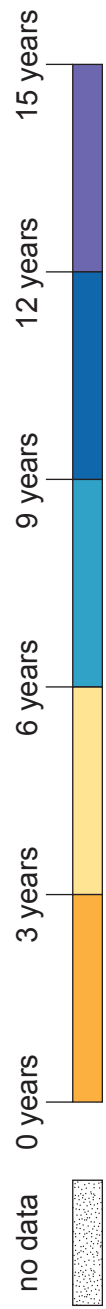

An urban area in the UK



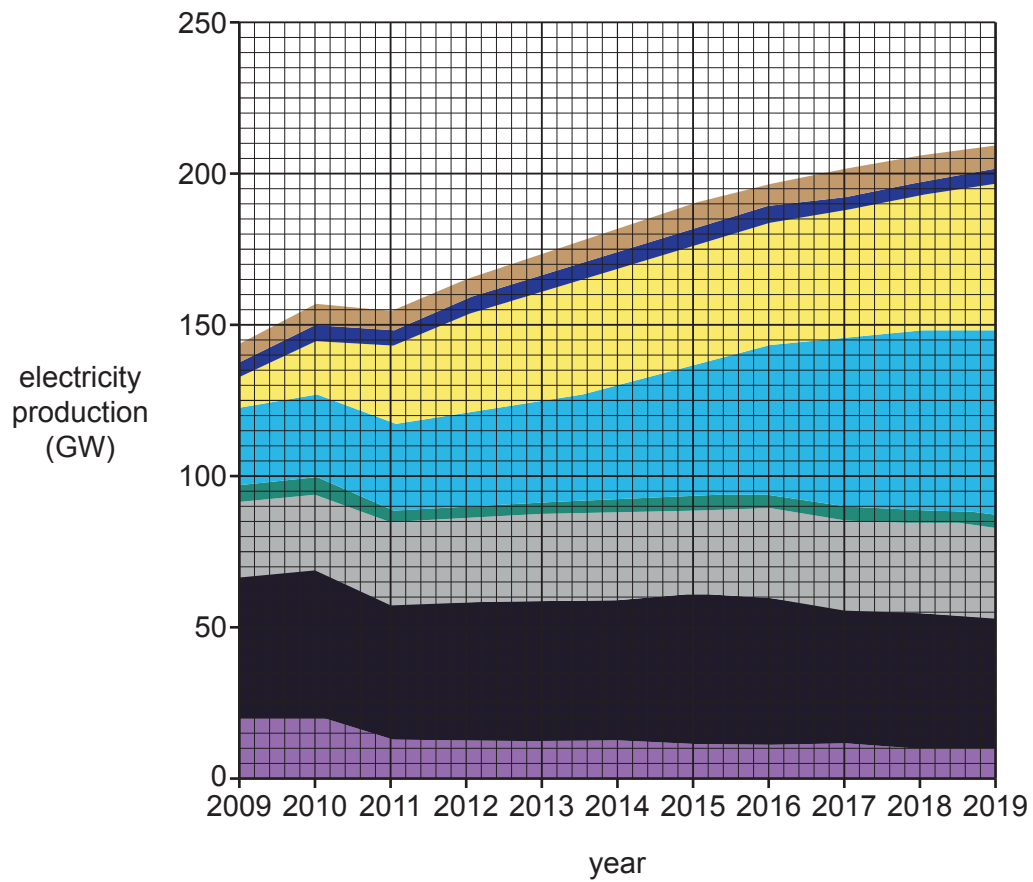
