

## Worksheet 8 answers

In a structured interview, questions are presented by the interviewer in a fixed order. In questionnaires, using open questions will produce *qualitative* data. 2 A score on a *psychometric* test such as an IQ test will produce quantitative data. *Participant* observations in which a researcher is involved in the social setting they are observing 4 may produce subjective data. 'Do you use social media?' is an example of a *closed* question. 5 Behavioural categories should be operationalised in an observational study. 6
