Feature	Evaluatio	on Carlos Ca
Overt / Covert	Туре:	This is an overt observation as the <u>worker</u> will know I am observing them.
	Strength:	The study is ethically sound as participants are aware that they are being observed at work and have given their permission (informed consent).
	Weakness:	The workers might avoid non-work related topics of conversation as they are being observed which lowers the validity of the study.
Naturalistic / Controlled	Type:	This is a naturalistic observation as I would be in the participants' natural environment (the workplace).
	Strength:	Participants should behave more normally as they are in the familiar environment with <u>co-workers</u> they know well which can improve the validity of the findings.
	Weakness:	It could be challenging to hear all the conversations in a <u>busy workplace</u> , as I would have no control over background noise, for example.
Structured / Unstructured	Type:	This is a structured observation, as I will record in a checklist whether the conversations were <u>about work or not about work</u> .
	Strength:	Quantitative data will be produced, e.g. minutes spent talking about work or about other topics which is a reliable method.
	Weakness:	In designing the checklist I may not have captured all behavioural categories, for example if participants talk about the economy, this may or may not be work-related which lowers the reliability of my findings.
