

The candidate describes their teamwork in the first two paragraphs of the reflective paper. This tells a story about their teamwork rather than giving focus to evaluating the teamwork.

There is one evaluative comment where the candidate talks about putting all of their findings into one Word document and how this was useful to them when making the PowerPoint.

Paragraphs 5 and 6 are also largely descriptive and do not delve into the strengths and weakness of their teamwork and how this impacted them. The candidate is awarded 3 marks for AO2a.

Paragraph 3 is where this candidate was awarded marks for reflecting on their learning. The candidate reflects that while completing the project they gained a lot of new knowledge about the topic, mainly about how complex and challenging to solve it is.

In paragraph 6 the candidate reflects on what they have learnt about greenhouse gasses too. The candidate is awarded 3 marks for AO2b.

Mark awarded for AO2a = 3 out of 10

Mark awarded for AO2b = 3 out of 10

Total mark awarded = 6 out of 10

How the candidate could improve the answer:

- The candidate needed to use more evaluative comments about teamwork rather than just describing what happened. They also needed to include their strengths and weaknesses and how this impacted their project. The candidate could have reflected on how they would improve in the future.
- The candidate needed to have a more specific focus on what they learnt. They needed to show what they knew to begin with and what they know now having completed the team project.
