Answer any questions they might have. • Encourage learners to work as a group to assign group roles and agree how to present their work. • Timekeep during group presentations. • Facilitate peer feedback and discussion of presentations.	
End (5 mins)	Ask learners to complete reflection task on presentation work to improve for next time.
