Beginning (5 mins)	Complete a word association task with learners, asking them to rapidly respond with knowledge and ideas about the terms listed.	
Middle (50 mins)	 Explain the three stations of the revision carousel, covering the three theories of motivation and needs. Organise learners into groups and support time management of the activity. Ask learners at their final station to share one of the review tasks with the rest of the class. Clarify any misunderstandings and gaps in knowledge. 	
End (5 mins)	Ask learners to complete the traffic light exercise reflecting on their confidence and understanding of the subtopics. Use this information to inform the review task for the following lesson.
